When you arrive in **Rome**, also known as the Eternal City, a private vehicle will be ready and waiting to welcome you and take you to your hotel.

As you journey to the hotel, you'll see why Rome is considered the epitome of historical richness in the Western world. You have the rest of the day free to unwind and enjoy the Italian capital at your leisure.

**Greca Tip:** Add extra nights during Step 1 of 3 to extend your stay and make the most of your time in Rome.





## DO AS THE ROMANS DO

After enjoying a delightful breakfast, you'll have the entire day to **explore Rome** at your own pace. With countless options at your fingertips, you can choose to wander around on foot, visit magnificent monuments, indulge in shopping, or savor the local cuisine, which offers a wide array of pasta, vegetable, meat, and fish dishes.

Rome holds a special place as the epicenter of the Catholic religion and boasts the highest concentration of historical and architectural treasures in the world. In 1980, Rome, along with the extraterritorial properties of the Holy See within the city and the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, was rightfully inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage list.

Greca Tip: If you wish, you can opt to visit the Colosseum, either



in the morning or the afternoon. Simply select your preference during Step 1 of the reservation process.

Don't miss out on the must-see landmarks such as the **Colosseum** and the **Forum**, as well as taking a stroll through the vibrant **Roman squares** adorned with captivating fountains.

In the evening, you can enjoy a dinner of your choice and unwind with a rejuvenating night's sleep at your hotel.

**Greca Tip:** For a memorable dining experience in Rome, we recommend exploring the Trastevere neighborhood and trying one of the charming trattorias. Indulge in a delectable Italian seafood dish paired with a glass of their house white wine.



## ARRIVEDERCI ROMA; ZDRAVO SPLIT

After enjoying your breakfast, you will be transferred to Rome International Airport at the designated time for your **flight to Split**.

Upon arrival in Split, you will be greeted and taken to your hotel. You will have free time to **explore Split** on your own.

**Split** is considered one of Croatia's most beautiful cities. It is the country's second-largest city and offers a wide range of cultural, historical, and diverse tour options, including water activities and hiking.

**Greca Tip:** While taking a stroll along the **Riva Promenade**, be sure to treat yourself to a classic "cevapi" dish, a local favorite.



## **5** GET TO KNOW SPLIT

After having a full breakfast, you will be able to explore the vibrant Mediterranean town of Split at your own pace. The story of Split is already 17 centuries old, dating to the time the Roman Emperor Diocletian decided to build his Palace right on the peninsula near the great Roman city of Salona, where he wanted to spend the last years of his life. During these 1700 years, the Palace slowly turned into a city, which to this day lures with its rich tradition, glorious history, and beauty of its natural and cultural heritage.

Diocletian Palace and the entire historical core of Split have been



on the World Heritage UNESCO list ever since 1979, not only for the extraordinary preservation of the Palace but also because the Palace and its city (or the city and its Palace, if you like) continue to live a full life.

All historical layers from old Rome, Middle Ages till today are still visible and alive in this structure. A walk through the ancient city takes you through time, along the great examples of ancient architecture like Peristyle, the middle-aged Romanesque Church and Gothic Palace, Renaissance portals of the noblemen's houses, Baroque facades, and modern architecture superbly merged in the rich heritage.

**Greca Tip:** The Diocletian's Palace boasted a splendid adornment of twelve sphinxes sourced from the ancient Egyptian pharaoh Thutmosis III. Today, however, only a mere trio remains, bearing witness to the passage of time.



#### FROM SPLIT TO DUBROVNIK

Today, after a complete breakfast, you will go on your own to the designated point to take your transport to **Dubrovnik**, the Pearl of the Adriatic.

Upon arrival, you will go on your own to the hotel. The rest of the day is free to start exploring.

There are many beautiful places in the world. However, the people of Dubrovnik claim their city to be the most beautiful. A warm southern climate, spacious blue skies, emerald green and dark blue crystal-clear sea touching the rocky shore and spilling into numerous coves and bays onto sandy beaches and steep reefs decorated with the lushest Mediterranean and subtropical flora.

**Greca Tip:** The drains in the streets hide a legend: if you are a single woman, you should not step on them because you could stay single forever. Will it be true?



## FREE DAY IN DUBROVNIK

After a peaceful and fabulous breakfast, you will have the day free to enjoy "The Pearl of the Adriatic."

**Dubrovnik** is a walled city dating back to the 7th century, full of contrasts and fusion that continues to enchant its visitors. Strolling within the walled area, we will reminisce about hundreds of years of history. Its walls and towers are considered the main attraction of the city, and from there we can capture breathtaking panoramic photos.

You shouldn't miss a visit to the Church of St. Blaise (1715), located



in the heart of the city, the Stradun Street, the main artery of the city, where we will find bars and shops, and also the Franciscan Monastery and its church (14th century), home to the oldest pharmacy in the world.

To further explore the city's history, we recommend visiting the Sponza Palace, which dates back to the 16th century. We can also take a funicular ride to Mount Srđ to enjoy the views and have a good cup of coffee.

**Greca Tip:** Explore the city walls of Dubrovnik for breathtaking panoramic views of the Adriatic Sea and the old town.

After breakfast, you are going to be transferred to **Dubrovnik International Airport** to board your next flight.
