EMBARK IN VIENNA: THE JOURNEY BEGINS

You will begin your embarkation at the **Handelskai dock in Vienna** starting at 4:00 PM. Once on board, you will settle into your cabin and prepare to enjoy this exciting adventure.

Next, you will participate in a charming **welcome cocktail**. This is the perfect moment to meet your fellow travelers and toast to the exciting days ahead.

You will spend the night docked in the city, offering you the opportunity to enjoy the night view of the place from the comfort of the ship. Dinner will be served on board, allowing you to savor a delicious meal while enjoying the relaxed and elegant atmosphere of the ship.

Greca Tip: Don't miss the chance to observe the city illuminated from the ship's deck. The view is simply magical and an unforgettable experience.



DAY AT VIENNA

After an exquisite breakfast, you can embark on a panoramic tour of the most important sights of the Austrian capital: the Opera House, the City Hall, the Parliament, the Burgtheater, and the splendid Imperial Palace of Hofburg.

In the afternoon, you can enjoy the city at your own pace or choose to take the optional visit to **Schönbrunn Palace**, known for its magnificent baroque architecture and extensive gardens. The palace, which served as the summer residence of the Habsburgs, witnessed numerous important events in the life of this dynasty that ruled Austria and much of Europe for centuries. At midnight, the ship will leave the Austrian capital and sail towards the Wachau Valley, famous for its picturesque landscapes and vineyards.

Greca Tip: Don't miss the chance to try a Viennese coffee at one of the historic cafes in the city. It's a unique experience that will make you feel like a true local.



MELK - DÜRNSTEIN

You will start the day with a delicious breakfast. Early in the morning, we dock in **Melk**, a small town located in the heart of the stunning Wachau Valley. It is world-renowned for the Benedictine Abbey situated atop a rock overlooking the river that you can visit.

At noon, you will leave Melk to enjoy the landscapes offered by the wonderful **Wachau Valley**.

After lunch, you will arrive in **Dürnstein**, a charming village in the heart of the winding Wachau Valley with a medieval castle. From the dock, you can directly access the historic center of the town on foot, passing through the medieval gates and reaching Pranger Square. From here, there is a beautiful view of the castle ruins, famous for being the place where Richard the Lionheart was allegedly imprisoned.

In the late afternoon, the ship will leave the town of Dürnstein and navigate towards Hungary.

Greca Tip: Don't miss the opportunity to taste the typical wines of the Wachau region.



ESZTERGOM - BUDAPEST

After a delicious breakfast, you will have the morning free to marvel at the stunning beauty of the **Danube**. This majestic river, winding through picturesque and charming landscapes, offers spectacular views of rolling hills, lush forests, and quaint villages along its banks.

After lunch, you will arrive in **Esztergom**, an important historical site in Hungary. It was the first capital of the Kingdom of Hungary and the place where the first king, Stephen I, was crowned in the year 1000. The Esztergom Basilica is the largest church in Hungary and a symbol of the city. Inside, you'll find the largest organ in the country.

At dinner time, we will set sail towards **Budapest**, arriving at midnight. You will have an overnight stay in the city.

Greca Tip: In Esztergom, enjoy a stroll through the old town, where you can admire the historic architecture, small shops, and cozy cafes.



ENJOYING BUDAPEST

After a delicious breakfast on board, you will spend the entire day in the vibrant capital of Hungary, **Budapest**. You can take a guided tour through the city's wide boulevards, visiting the impressive Parliament, the elegant Opera House, Heroes' Square, and the bustling Central Market. We will also cross the iconic Chain Bridge and explore the Fisherman's Bastion, where spectacular views of the city await us. As night falls, Budapest transforms into a dazzling spectacle.

Don't miss the chance to admire the city illuminated and discover its nighttime magic at your own pace. **Greca Tip:** At the Fisherman's Bastion, make sure to try the

famous Hungarian sweet pastries while enjoying the stunning nighttime views of the city.



6 BUDAPEST, THE PEARL OF THE DANUBE

One excellent way to admire the panoramic views of the Danube and the UNESCO World Heritage sites is to take Tram No. 2, which runs along the river from Margaret Bridge to Petőfi Bridge. This ride provides a unique view of the city's main landmarks.

Alternatively, you can immerse yourself in the waters of one of Budapest's famous **thermal baths**. The Széchenyi and Gellért baths are among the most renowned and offer a relaxing experience in a historic setting.

In the afternoon, you will take in the views offered by the Danube and its banks. The beauty of the river, surrounded by historic buildings and picturesque landscapes, is a sight not to be missed. **Greca Tip:** If you choose to visit the Széchenyi Thermal Baths, make sure to try one of their refreshing cocktails in the outdoor pool—it's a fantastic way to combine relaxation with enjoyment!





EXPLORING BRATISLAVA
